4. MUD Urban Design Representation Course development and convening: 102hours in Term 1 & 2, Semester 1.
Total teaching hours = 102hours

Part-time Contract 3: URBAN DESIGN THEORY

5. MUD Urban Design Theory support teaching: 104hours in Semester 1 and/or 2.
Total teaching hours = 104hours

The posts are suited to Urban Designers who are either running their own practices or who are employed in Urban Design, Planning and/or Architectural firms. Particular consideration will be given to applicants who have demonstrated interest to pursue post-graduate study / work or have research interest or demonstrate capacity and aptitude for design thinking and previous teaching experience. *Remuneration will be negotiated dependent upon expertise.*
